UNDER 13'S AND BELOW USE FREEWHEEL BIKES IN GOOD WORKING ORDER e.g. Mountain bikes or Cyclo-Cross Bikes WITH MOUNTAIN BIKE OR CYCLO-CROSS TYPE TYRES (NO SMOOTH/ROAD TYRES\*\*)

\*\*TYRES WITH SIMILAR LIGHT TREADS SUCH AS THE Challenge Strada Bianca Open

**Tubular Tyre are NOT Suitable.)** 

All Tyres must have a clearly visible tread and not just be a grippy road bike tyre.

### COMMISSAIRES DECISION WILL BE FINAL ON SUITABILITY OF TYRES

Please contact the organisers in advance if you have any questions regarding gear restrictions or tyre choices.

Riders in Y9 and above are not eligible this year (UNDER 15'S/OVER 15'S USE FIXED WHEEL TRACK BIKES WITH MOUNTAIN BIKE OR CYCLO-CROSS TYRES in grass track we will look to run competition for this age group in future events)

The Riders must compete by their own efforts. The Heats etc may change depending on numbers signing on.

The championship is in the form of an omnium consisting of three counting events, a sprint, a time trial or pursuit and a scratch race. Proposed points for Youth Omnium:1 for 1<sup>st</sup> then ,2,3,4,5,6,7etc, lowest points win. In case of a tie for the event we will go back to the **Scratch** results, If still tied, back to time trial/ pursuit time. The heats and pursuit stations may change depending on who attends on the day.

Triathlon bars and Spinache style bar extensions are not permitted in any BSCA Massed start events. Spinache bars are not allowed in any event.

Aero style helmets are not to be used in mass start events.

Please do not cross the track while racing is in progress.

Line up in Number Order just off the start line.


# **FOUR STATION PURSUIT (Omnium 2 of 3)**

# 2018-2019 Age Categories

BSCA Age categories and Gear Restrictions for 2018/2019

For Circuit, Time Trial, Track and Roller Racing Regional and National Championships, the maximum gear will be the distance covered per crank revolution for that age group.

Generally, the following age categories apply but it is the child's age on the 1st September at the start of the school year e.g. If a child was 11 on the 1st September 2018, they will be Under 13.
